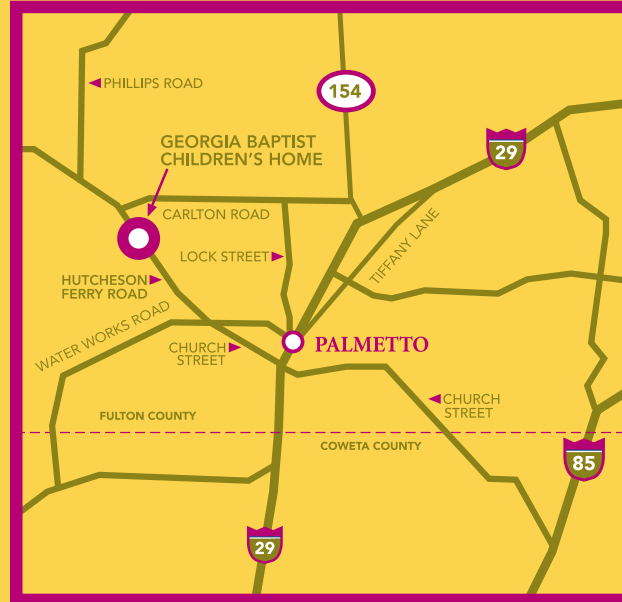

The day before Riley's 2nd birthday, she was diagnosed with Mitochondrial Disease. This disease causes her to be non-verbal, have abnormal brain function, gastro-intestinal problems, muscle failure and delayed development. These symptoms are specific to Riley's case, but the disease impacts everyone differently..



The problems associated with Mitochondrial disease are caused by defective mitochondria — the parts of the cell that generate energy. Currently, there is no cure, and the average life expectancy is late childhood or early adulthood.

Today, Riley is 8 years old and we cope with her disease with the help of multiple specialists, therapists and an incredible special needs school - The Joseph Sams School.

The Joseph Sams School is located in Fayetteville, Georgia and serves children with all sorts of special needs. The school has allowed Riley to become more independent and learn life-long skills. There she is loved, accepted and challenged to reach her full potential in life.

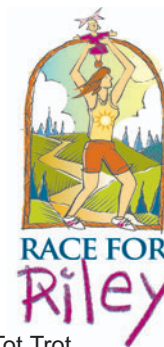
